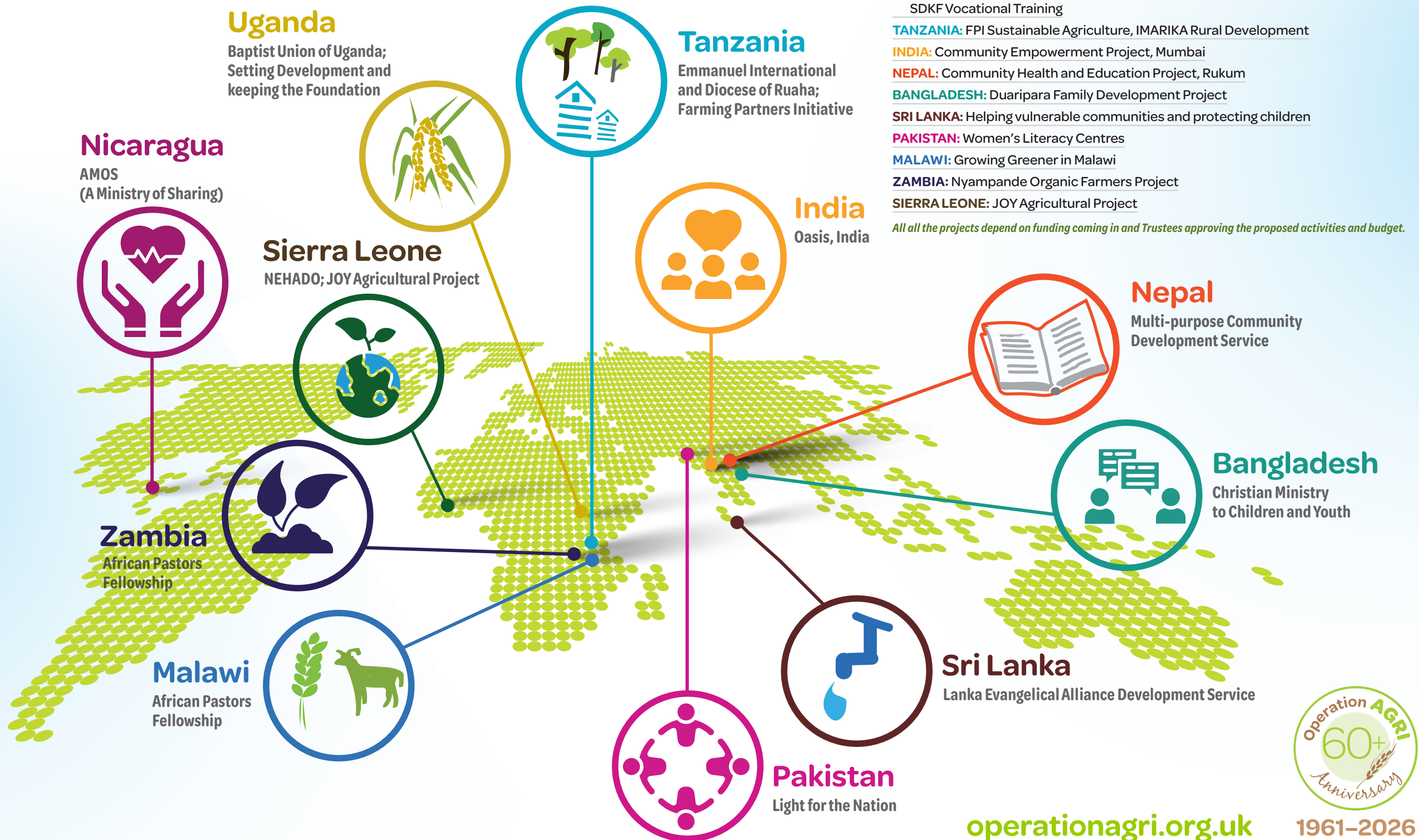

Operation Agri works with local Christian partners in eleven countries. Operation Agri helps grow food, increase incomes, teach skills, empower women and much more.





NICARAGUA

Community-based Primary Healthcare

Project: AMOS is primarily concerned with improving health in Nicaragua, the second poorest country in Latin America. It seeks to achieve this by building the capacity of Community-based Primary Health Workers throughout Nicaragua. Health Leaders are appointed in the villages and these fully trained volunteers are equipped with educational materials, medications, equipment and supplies to strengthen community health systems, and implement practices that improve physical, spiritual, and emotional well-being.

PRAYER

May God guide and encourage them as they continue to serve these needy communities.



UGANDA

Sustainable Agriculture Farming Initiatives

Teaches rural subsistence farms to become agro businesses by increasing yields through conservation agriculture and introducing better breeds and crop varieties. Supplies training to decrease reliance on expensive bought in resources.

PRAYER

That farmers will encourage neighbours to adopt the new methods being taught, so farms' productivity increases and leads to a better standard of living.

Women's Adult Literacy Project

Teaches illiterate women to read and write in Rutooro and to calculate. Encourages the women to form groups which co-operate in sharing knowledge and in forming Village Banks.

PRAYER

Give thanks for the many households that have benefitted from the training.

SDKF Vocational Training

Started in 2006 and has trained nearly 2,000 disadvantaged youths in Tailoring, Hairdressing, Motor Cycle Maintenance and more recently in Carpentry.

PRAYER

Pray that the students will apply the skills they have been taught to transform their lives.

Pray that the teachers will have patience to teach in such a way that the students can easily understand.



TANZANIA

Sustainable Agriculture Farming Initiatives

FPI in Karagwe, led by Pastor Heavenlight Luoga trains up to 125 farmers in sustainable farming in each 2 year phase, to improve crop yields in the face of climate change.

PRAYER

Pray for groups that have completed their training as well as those still in training, that they'll work together to the benefit of their community.

IMARIKA

Project: Groups are formed from those interested in the village. They receive initial teaching in working together and using local resources. People who decide to stay part of the group, receive training in Village Community Banking and health. They also choose two of the following areas in which to receive extra training: conservation agriculture, fuel efficient stove making, afforestation, beekeeping or poultry keeping. Loans from the Village Bank have enabled many of the members to start new businesses. Training has recently started with groups in secondary schools.

PRAYER

Pray for wisdom for the IMARIKA team in choosing and training new groups, also for unity in the groups.



INDIA

Community Empowerment Project

The project serves the community of Bhaskar Nagar in Kalwa East, Mumbai, and aims to equip residents with transformational skills and knowledge, focusing on education, health care, and community safety. It seeks especially to impact the lives of girls and boys aged 6-17 through skill development, education, and a supportive environment; women aged 18+ through vocational training, awareness, and gender-related empowerment; and young men (18-35) through skill training, addressing drug addiction and promoting positive behaviour change.

PRAYER

That Oasis India may recruit and retain project staff with the appropriate skills and experience.



NEPAL

CHEP Mahatgaun

The CHEP project of MCDS is located in a remote location which until recently had no vehicle access. It operates by establishing and equipping Self Help Groups, mainly of women, a forum in which the community can learn new skills and knowledge. Protection and sustainability of the groups is secured by the formation and registration of local Co-operatives. The CHEP team provides training in agriculture, education and adult literacy classes.

PRAYER

Pray that this final year will bring security and sustainability through the building of local commitment to the activities and good relationships with local stakeholders.



BANGLADESH

Duaripara Family Development Project

The project supports the development of 100 girls aged 3-13 who are currently, or potentially, at risk of sexual and / or commercial exploitation. The project does this by providing educational support for the girls, who would otherwise struggle to get an education; enhancing their life skills and confidence; helping them to understand their rights; encouraging them to adopt more positive health seeking behaviour; and by working to provide an environment where the girls are safe and secure.

PRAYER

That the girls may develop in ways which enable them to make positive life choices.



SRI LANKA

Strengthening Community Structures for Sustainable Development in Killinochchi

The project seeks to empower communities in Killinochchi that were deeply impacted by the civil war that ended in 2009, especially to raise their voice in support of child rights and to promote an improved economic environment. It seeks to do this through strengthening the communities' advocacy capacity, both children and adults; to promote collaboration between communities and local authorities; and to create and strengthen self-help groups for stable income generation.

PRAYER

That the children may grow in knowledge and confidence so that they may be effective advocates for their rights.



PAKISTAN

Women's Skills and Literacy Centres

Light for the Nation empowers women in Punjab, Pakistan, through training in beautician work, sewing, literacy, and advocacy. Many are Christian women facing poverty and bonded labour. Over 6-12 months, they gain practical skills, financial literacy, and confidence to pursue better livelihoods. The project also teaches women their rights, aiming to restore dignity, reduce inequality, and inspire hope.

PRAYER

Pray for LFTN's ministry among persecuted Christians - for protection, provision, and spiritual growth. Pray that advocacy brings justice to the oppressed. Thank God for the confidence this work instils in these women.



MALAWI

Growing Greener in Malawi

This project has just been restarted after a year's pause following the death of the pastor who began it. A new team is continuing the training of groups of farmers in combating climate change and improving food security. It operates in two areas, the Lower Shire and Ncheu district. In the former area, where flooding from cyclones is more likely, 'Winter' crops are grown after these events making use of water left in the soil and the use of hybrid short season maize, so harvest can be achieved before the next rains begin.

PRAYER

Pray that the new team will continue to work well together and get a good response from the farmers.



ZAMBIA

Nyampande Organic Farmers Project

The project began in 2023. Each year, a new area is chosen and the project leader asks the local leaders to organise a meeting. Training in making organic fertiliser from locally available materials is given to those farmers who attend. In the past, farmers would borrow from the money lenders to buy inorganic fertiliser, and if the harvest failed or was poor, would struggle to repay their debt.

PRAYER

Help those who attend the training, to understand what is being taught, and put it into practice correctly.



SIERRA LEONE

Joy Agricultural Project

New Harvest Ministries Development Office (NEHADO) launched a two-year project in January 2025 to empower subsistence farmers in Northern Sierra Leone's Koinadugu District. Joy Agricultural Project trains 28 local 'resource people' in climate-resilient farming across 14 communities.

Each resource person mentors 20 farmers, helping them adopt improved agricultural practices and form Village Savings and Loans Associations (VSLAs) to boost income and resilience.

PRAYER

Pray for the lasting impact of the training, that farmers and communities will be strengthened through increased agricultural productivity and resilience, and that God's Kingdom will be revealed through this work.
